LOVING OF NEIGHBOUR

One of the teachers of the law came and heard them debating. Noticing that Jesus had given them a good answer, he asked him, "Of all the commandments, which is the most important?"

"The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' Mark 12:28-31

For many of us this time of crisis can lead to reflections on our present predicament. How can something so small and unseen as a little virus have such a devastating effect upon our lives?! Or, as some of you asked: "Is this a judgement from God"? I don't believe it is.

For years now Mark 12: 30-31 has been clunking around in my mind. In these verses Jesus sums up the Law: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, Love your neighbour as you love yourself". But how can we love our neighbour even as we are locked into our homes?

Even these days two things stood out for me. The first was sparked off by remarks made by Texas Lieutenant Governor Dan Patrick who indicated that a 3 month lockdown would destroy the America he loves



and so 70 plussers should do the decent thing and take the risk of dying for their children and grandchildren so that the economy can keep going. What has struck me was that this sentiment is not around in most of the US or in the rest of the world. We seemingly do not question the need to help the weakest (or oldest) in our society and so we stay at home to protect the NHS so that it will be able to cope. Governments in most countries are going much further than ever in their support both business and employees with a massive cash injection. Is this loving your neighbour in action?

A second observation that struck me was how many people have lived out that command of 'loving our neighbour'. We had notes through our door offering help with shopping if we fell ill and another



note inviting us, three times a week, to stand outside our house, drink a cup of coffee or tea (keeping our distance), whilst (shouting) asking and each other: "how are you doing?". I hear of people who have rung, texted, Skyped whatever method is available and are asking 'how are you doing?'. When we go for our hour walk in our neighbourhood, total strangers cross the street (away) and say 'good morning' and 'keep safe'.

This time of crisis shows us what it means to be human, the way that God has made us in His image, He is a loving God. We are created to love our neighbour and so when we watch all those small acts of love -shopping done for an elderly neighbour- a phone call made to check up on someone- what we are witnessing is women, men and children reflecting a loving God.

And for those who walk with Jesus in these times? The imperative is even greater than ever to express this love that is in us to be pro-active in this living a life of love as Jesus did.

And finally, love yourselves, look after yourselves and stay safe, spend time with God so that His love for you can feed you.
